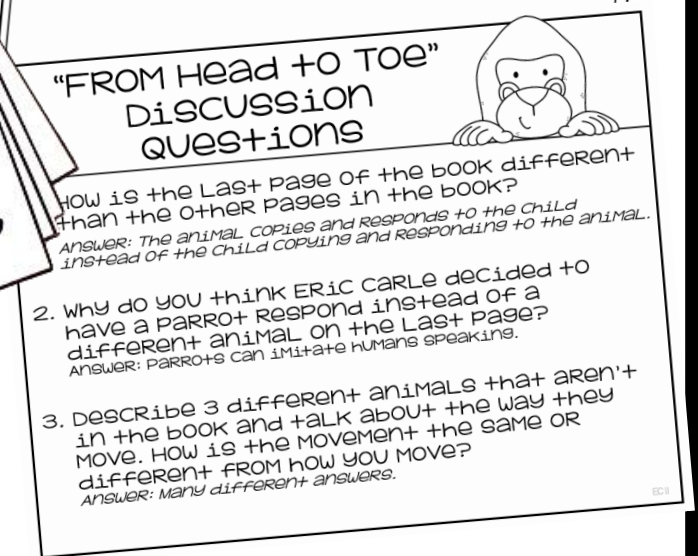
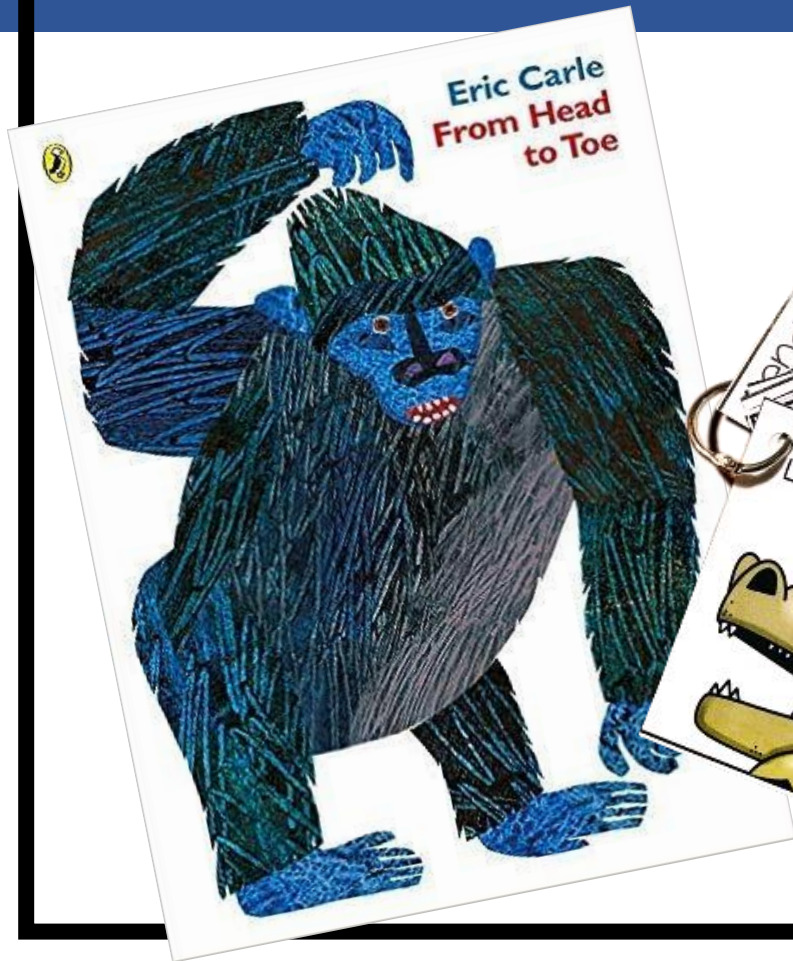

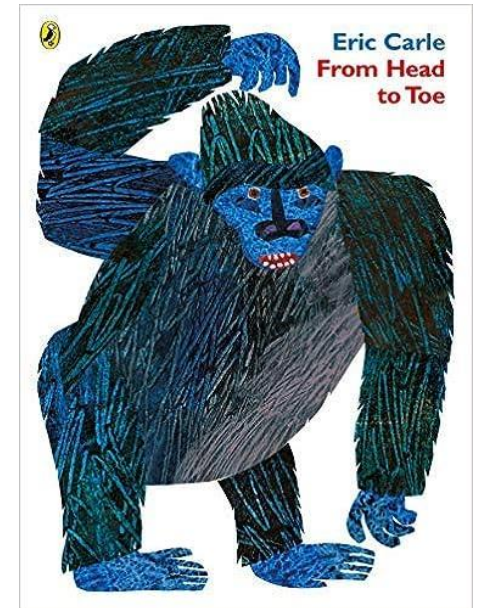
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FROM HEAD TO TOE

"FROM HEAD TO TOE" DISCUSSION QUESTIONS



1. HOW IS THE LAST PAGE OF THE BOOK DIFFERENT THAN THE OTHER PAGES IN THE BOOK?

2. WHY DO YOU THINK ERIC CARLE DECIDED TO HAVE A PARROT RESPOND INSTEAD OF A DIFFERENT ANIMAL ON THE LAST PAGE?

ANSWER: PARROTS CAN IMITATE HUMANS SPEAKING.

3. DESCRIBE 3 DIFFERENT ANIMALS THAT AREN'T IN THE BOOK AND TALK ABOUT THE WAY THEY MOVE. HOW IS THE MOVEMENT THE SAME OR DIFFERENT FROM HOW YOU MOVE?
